

Dear Dr. Dudley,

Will I be able to get a job when I grow up if I have epilepsy?

Dear Joe,

Lots of people with epilepsy can, and do live normal lives and can be exceptional professionals. Many footballers, athletes, authors, politicians, business people, doctors, nurses, mechanics, chefs, engineers, parents and artists have epilepsy. You might not able to join the forces like the Army or be a pilot, however there are many other professions you might like to do. You will always need to consider your safety when considering a place of work, equally the workplace will need to know how to keep you safe in the event of a seizure as well.

If you have epilepsy, you can still become involved in other activities, go out on dates and enjoy your life as an adult. Your doctor and your parents will give you instructions about taking precautions to protect yourself in various situations. For example, children and teenagers with epilepsy can enjoy swimming, but should always swim with other people to be safe.

Aside from some safety precautions, though, you can enjoy all the stuff your friends and classmates do. As long as epilepsy is under medical control, people with epilepsy are able to drive providing they feel safe to do so. Tell the people close to you — friends, relatives, teachers, coaches — about your epilepsy and teach them what to do in case you have a seizure when they're with you.






